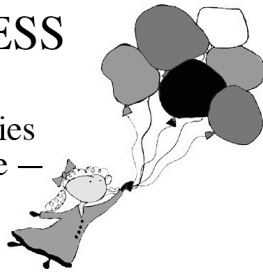

Role-plays

1. For the third day in a row you cannot get through your math problems. How do you get help?
2. You and your partner have only one pencil between you. Your teacher has asked you to write a paragraph about what “freedom” means to you. What do you do?
3. (boys) You and your partner want to check out a ball on the playground. You want to play basketball with it and he wants to play handball. What do you do?
3. (girls) It’s rainy day and you and your partner decide to play cards inside. You want to play canasta and she wants to play gin rummy. What do you do?
4. You and your partner agreed to meet at the park at 2 o’clock one Saturday afternoon. Your partner doesn’t show up. You walk back home and call her/him on the phone. He/she says he/she forgot, which makes you a little mad. What do you do now?
5. You and your partner are walking home from school on a cold and rainy day. You have an umbrella, but no coat, and your partner has a coat but no umbrella. What can you do to stay both warm and dry?
6. You and your partner are playing a card game and you start arguing over one of the rules. Finally, your partner throws down his/her cards and says, “I’m not playing anymore!” What do you do?
7. You didn’t turn in your homework for the third day in a row. Role-play the conversation you have with your teacher.
